Eileen Myles, called by BUST magazine “the rock star of modern poetry,” is the author of more than twenty books of poetry and prose, including *Chelsea Girls*; *Cool for You*; *Sorry, Tree*; *Not Me*; and the recently published *The Importance of Being Iceland: Travel Essays in Art*. *The Inferno: a Poet’s Novel* will be out next year. Myles directed the Poetry Project at St. Marks in the 1980s and was head of the Writing Program at the University of California-San Diego from 2002 to 2007. She’s the recent recipient of an Andy Warhol/Creative Capital Foundation Fellowship and lives in New York.
