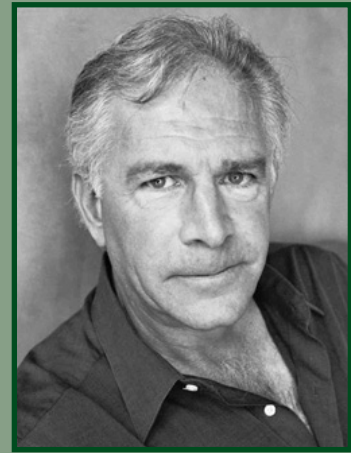

Andrew Joron lives in Berkeley, California. He has won the Rhysling Award three times, and the Gertrude Stein Award twice. His books include *The Sound Mirror* (Flood Editions, 2008), *The Cry at Zero: Selected Prose* (Counterpath Press, 2007), as well as 9 others.

Andrew Zawacki is a poet, critic, editor, and translator. His first book of poetry, *By Reason of Breakings*, won the 2001 University of Georgia Contemporary Poetry Series Award. His other books include *Petals of Zero*, *Petals of One* (Talisman House, 2009), and *Anabranch* (Wesleyan Univ Press, 2004).

Michael Palmer is the author of numerous books of poetry, including *Company of Moths* (New Directions, 2005), which was shortlisted for the Canadian Griffin Poetry Prize; *Codes Appearing: Poems 1979-1988* (2001); *The Promises of Glass* (2000); *The Lion Bridge: Selected Poems 1972-1995* (1998); *At Passages* (1996); *Sun* (1988); *First Figure* (1984); *Notes for Echo Lake* (1981); *Without Music* (1977); *The Circular Gates* (1974); and *Blake's Newton* (1972). He is also the author of a prose work, *The Danish Notebook* (Avec Books, 1999). He has translated work from French, Russian, and Portuguese, and has collaborated with painters and dancers. His honors include two grants from the National Endowment for the Arts, a Lila Wallace-Reader's Digest Writer's Award, a Guggenheim Foundation fellowship, and the Shelley Memorial Prize from the Poetry Society of America. In 1999, he was elected a Chancellor of The Academy of American Poets. He lives in San Francisco and is married to the renowned architect Cathy Simon.

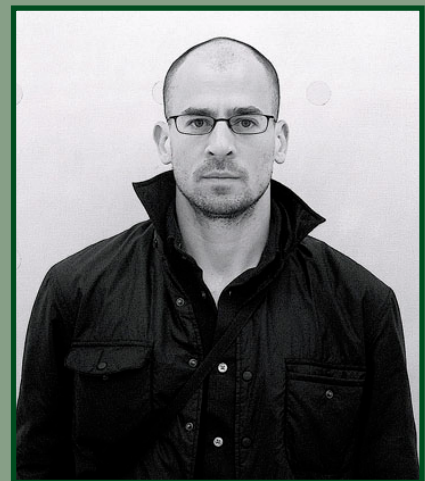
