Tracie Morris is an interdisciplinary poet who has worked extensively as a sound artist, writer, multimedia performer, and educator. Her sound poetry installations have been presented at the Whitney Biennial and the Jamaica Center for Arts and Learning. She has toured extensively throughout the United States, Canada, Europe, Africa, and Asia as a writer and bandleader. She has participated in over a dozen recording projects to date. Morris is the recipient of numerous awards for poetry and performance and has contributed to, and been written about in, several anthologies of literary criticism. She holds an MFA in poetry from Hunter College and a PhD in Performance Studies from New York University. Tracie Morris is currently the CPCW Fellow in Poetics and Poetic Practice at the University of Pennsylvania and Associate Professor of Humanities and Media Studies at Pratt Institute.
